ICAN Learn delivers the skill set in Financial Literacy Education to support the development of financial knowledge, equipping workforces with greater confidence in managing their own finances and the ability to share basic financial information with clients individually or as part of group community education.

This course comprises 3 units, called a 'skill set' which is not a full qualification, rather, completion of this accredited course gives you three (3) units of competency that contributes to Certificate III and IV Community Services.

This skill set is a great way to get into study or enhance your current qualification assisting you to find ways of supporting people to understand and change their money story for a better future.

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no course prerequisite qualifications, however students are required to demonstrate literacy and numeracy skills in line with Certificate IV level studies and be able to commit at four to six hours of personal study time in addition to class time. Applicants should have interest and/or relevant experience in the social and community services field and have the appropriate maturity and interpersonal skills to work with a diverse range of people.

#### COURSE DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered live online (in 'real-time') across 3 full days over 3 weeks; with 4 additional weeks to complete assessments.

#### ON COMPLETION

On completion of this course, you will be equipped to support individuals to reshape their "money story" through practical advice, targeted support, and financial literacy education. You will develop the skills to deliver both one-on-one and group-based financial education, helping clients build confidence and improve their financial wellbeing. This skill set provides a foundation for those working in community services, offering a pathway into further study or employment while enhancing your ability to deliver meaningful, client-focused support.

#### FEES
