This course is open to anyone living in Australia [residential status] who is seeking to gain skills in community services work including financial capability work.

Successful completion of the course provides you with Certificate IV Community Services with a specialist area of learning in financial literacy education giving you opportunities for future work in a range of community services and financial wellbeing and capability roles.

About ICAN Learn

ICAN Learn, an arm of the Indigenous Consumer Assistance Network [ICAN] is a social enterprise registered training organisation. Incorporated in 2007, ICAN is a national leader in consumer advocacy, financial counselling and financial literacy for Indigenous people; and develops and delivers specialist education for organisations.

Delivery mode

This course is delivered using a weekly remote real-time teaching approach.

Duration and Attendance

You are required to attend a weekly scheduled live online real time classes conducted over 2 sessions each day. There are several breaks scheduled in the calendar to give you time to get on top of assessments.

Assessment

Students are required to successfully complete some assessment tasks during and following the classroom delivery.

Study requirements

Students must be prepared to spend some personal study time in between classes to get through the learning and assessment requirements.

Course fees

Course fees are identified on the ICAN Learn website. Fees are invoiced in clusters of two units payable two weeks in advance of each cluster commencing. ICAN Learn has payment arrangements if you get into financial difficulty.

ICAN Learn has scholarships available for those who identify as Indigenous Australians or as people from a multicultural background who have arrived in Australia in the last 5 years and are resident here. Students are required to provide certified identification for enrolment to progress.
