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Financial Literacy Education Skill Set CHCSS00077

The Financial Literacy Education Skillset is a great way to enhance any community services role or to move into working in financial resilience roles. This skillset is not a full qualification, is easier to achieve and sets the participant on a study and work pathway.

If you're working in a community services or related role and want to enhance your work with clients, then this is the course for you! This skill set provides a set of skills for provision of basic financial literacy education to be used with clients and is not financial counselling.

Find ways of supporting people to change their money story and learn a bit about practical advice, support and financial literacy education by undertaking this course.

Financial capability workers provide direct client support and group education about financial literacy and assist financial wellbeing.

What are the outcomes?

Successful completion of the Financial Literacy Education Skillset assists the participant to gain the skills and knowledge required to apply these skills in financial capability and financial literacy education roles. This Financial Literacy Skillset is recognised nationally and is a required skillset for people employed as Financial Capability Workers and is desirable for many community services workers to enhance their skills and provide a more holistic approach to working with their clients.

What will I learn?

You'll learn about how to:

- Understand your own money story and how that influences the way you work with clients
- Tell others about important financial facts and rights
- Understand the financial challenges of individuals
- Apply client centred practices
- Identify financial needs of people from specific demographics
- Refer clients to other services including financial counselling

About the course

The Financial Literacy Education Skillset comprises 3 units of study and is an accredited skillset.

Delivery mode

This course is delivered using a weekly remote real time teaching approach.

Duration & Attendance

3 full days of remote real time learning. You are required to attend the scheduled live online real time classes which are conducted in 2 sessions each day.

Assessment

Students are required to successfully complete some assessment tasks following the classroom delivery.

Study requirements

Students must be prepared to spend about 4-6 hours on the assessment for this course following classroom delivery.

Course fees
