### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must be a financial counsellor with a minimum of 3 years full-time experience and hold full membership of the financial counselling peak body in their state or territory.

This course is delivered live online (in 'real-time') across 6 weeks, in 2 hour sessions
