ICAN Learn is proud to offer a new scholarship program for 2025. The scholarships are available for people who identify as First Nations or those who predominately work or plan to work with First Nations communities.

The scholarships cover all course fees for either the: **CHC51122 Diploma of Financial Counselling**; or **CHC42021 Certificate IV in Community Services** (including the skill set in Financial Literacy Education).

The delivery will be contextualised to working with First Nations people and communities and will delve into embedding the Indigenous Consumer Assistance Network's (ICAN Learn's parent organisation) well-being framework into practice. ICAN has been developing, testing, and refining its holistic financial counselling and financial capability practice framework over the past three years.

Through adopting and adapting the Sustainable Livelihoods Framework to ICAN's financial counselling and financial capability services, ICAN has now embedded a strengths-based well-being framework that supports people to move from crisis ('surviving') towards a 'thriving' position.
