

Rural Financial Counselling specialisation



Rural financial counselling is a specialist area of work. The units provided in this course are elective units in the Diploma of Financial Counselling CHC51115 that provide specific learning for financial counsellors to work in the role of Rural Financial Counsellor.

Not all financial counsellors are rural financial counsellors.

It takes specific skills to work in the designated role of rural financial counsellor. It's not simply about working in a rural location, it's a totally different job! Rural financial counsellors are funded to work with primary producers who are in financial difficulty.

The work is complex and includes aspects of succession planning through analysing the financial situation and business position of the primary producer.

This course includes 3 units that are from the Group A electives for the Rural Financial Counselling specialisation in the Diploma of Financial Counselling CHC51115.
