#### How do I get a scholarship?

To get a scholarship, you **must** 

- 1. Identify as Aboriginal / Torres Strait Islander; and
- 2. Be ready to learn and commit to study; and
- 3. Complete and submit an online scholarship application form; and
- 4. Attend a pre-training interview if accepted; and
- 5. Meet all aspects of course enrolment (includes requirements for Language, Literacy and Numeracy)
