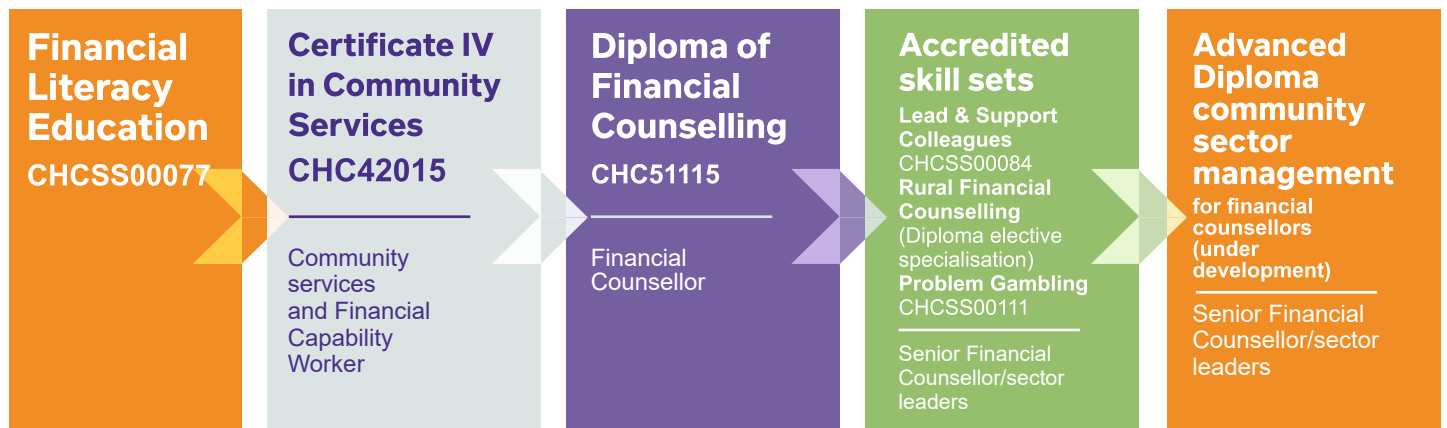
About ICAN Learn

What scholarships are on offer?

Certificate IV in Community Services [with 3 units [skill set] in financial literacy education]

Diploma of Financial Counselling [with skill set in financial literacy education as an additional feature]

Lead & Support Colleagues [3-unit skill set for qualified workers]

How do I get a scholarship?

To get a scholarship, you **must**

1. Identify as Aboriginal / Torres Strait Islander OR be a person from a multicultural background who has come to Australia in the last 10 years; and
2. Be ready to learn and commit to study; and
3. Complete and submit an online Scholarship Application Form; and
4. Attend a group interview if accepted; and
5. Meet all aspects of course enrolment (includes requirements for Language, Literacy and Numeracy)

When do applications open and close?

Program 1 Certificate IV Community Services including the 3 units in financial literacy education
Applications open on 1 July 2022

Program 2 Diploma of Financial Counselling (including the skill set in financial literacy education as an additional lead in). Applications opens in August 2022

Program 3 Lead & Support Colleagues (for qualified workers wanting to add skills to their portfolio) Applications open in November 2022 for early 2023 start.

Program 4 Certificate IV in Community Services including the 3 units in financial literacy education.
Application date TBA

Late applications may be eligible for other courses running later in 2023.

Note: Classes are compulsory and are held weekly in live online format.
Each course has a timetable which has scheduled breaks.
